



RiseKidz Procedures

Nursery/Toddlers:

- Ages are from new born to 3yrs old. When the child turns 4yrs old (And must be potty trained) the parents or adult guardian will be notified to start bringing the child to the gym with the older children.
- At check in, if your child has any allergies or any other needs please write it down on the check in sheet and or speak to the teachers or leader of the ministry.
- The parent or adult guardian must check in the child at the nursery front desk. At check in the child will have a wrist- band placed on them with their name and a number. That name and number will be placed on a card and given to the parent or adult guardian.
- The parent or adult guardian that checks in the child is the only one able to check out the child.
- When checking out the child the parent or adult guardian must bring the card that was given to them by the teacher.
- A bag with diapers and other items can be left with the teachers in the classroom. If you do not want the teachers to change your child's diaper than you must say so.
- If there are any issues with your child during the service, you will see the number that is on your card displayed on the TV monitor. Once you see your number please come immediately back to the nursery.

RiseKidz Procedures

Pre K / Elementary:

- Ages are from 4yrs old until child enters middle school (usually 11yrs old). When the child turns 11yrs old or has entered middle school the parents or adult guardian will be notified to start bringing the child to the middle school group.
- At check in, if your child has any allergies or any other needs please write it down on the check in sheet and or speak to the teachers or leader of the ministry.
- The parent or adult guardian must check in the child at the front desk. At check in the child will have a wrist- band placed on them with their name and a number. That name and number will be placed on a card and given to the parent or adult guardian.
- The parent or adult guardian that checks in the child is the only one able to check out the child.
- When checking out the child you must bring the card that was given to you by the teacher that matches the name and number on the child's wristband.
- If there are any issues with your child during the service, you will see the number that is on your card displayed on the TV monitor. Once you see your number please come immediately back to the gym.
